DEER HUNTING INFORMATION

Deer hunts: 6 nights/ 5 days, includes Rustic Cabin that sleeps 4-6, private land, just under 1,000 acres with both mule deer (75%) and whitetail (25%) present, ground blinds (heated if needed), and tree stands. We provide transportation to and from stands and blinds. Hunting is over trails and well-planned food plots.

Hunt fee: \$2,500.00 per person, with a 3 person minimum (2 person minimum for archery). 25% down payment is required to reserve and secure your hunt dates. Down payment is non refundable except in the case of not being drawn. Another 25% is due by July 10th. Balance due by Oct. 10th or you can bring cash (only) when you show up for the hunt.

The cabin is fully equipped with bedding, full kitchen, cooking and eating utensils, crock pots, outside gas grill, etc. Food is not included. Food can be provided for a nominal fee if preferred. Call to get quotes. This is a rustic cabin with outhouse. Showers and laundry facilities are available at the main house.

Non-resident deer license can be applied for from Jan. 2nd to May 31st. **Make sure to purchase a conservation stamp along with your license** Please apply early so you don't miss the dates. Drawing is confirmed on their website on June 20th. Our ranch location is in Region A, General Area 1. We promote quality deer management and we encourage applying for a doe tag, it's Type 001-7. There is no extra fee for shooting a doe. If you have any other questions on applying for your licence just call Wyoming Game and Fish at 307-777-4600 or <https://wgfd.wyo.gov/> . They have a person always willing to help.

- **Equipment:** Rifle sighted in for 200 yards. Most shots will be less, but it's always nice to be ready for a further out shot. Please practice. A wounded, but not retrieved deer, is YOUR deer. We are always ready to help track wounded deer and spend whatever time necessary to recover if possible.
- **Range Finder:** Trust me, distances appear way different in our more open country and can be deceiving. We want your hunt to be successful.
- **Clothing:** Temperatures can range from -10 degrees to 55 degrees, so layering along with a windbreak is suggested. Wyoming requires minimal fluorescent orange or pink, a hat or vest will do. Check with Wyoming Game and Fish for their most recent requirements.
- **Other Incidentals:** Binoculars, rain suit, mud boots, shooting sticks, flashlights, etc.
- **Processing:** Wyoming (and most other states) now require that deer be processed before crossing the state line. You can skin and bone out your deer in our pole barn. We have hanging racks and cutting tables for your use. Bring your own butchering equipment, cutting boards, wrapping paper, vacuum packer, coolers, etc. There are butcher shops available if you don't want to do your own processing.
